He quickly moved to the "bigger" sister station in Waco, Texas, News Channel 25, his chance to learn more about the job and work in a faster news environment.

John next spent four years honing his craft at CBS58 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, where he received his first Emmy nomination and win.

In 2015, John decided to gamble on himself and move home to Massachusetts without a job. He hoped to be hired in Boston, one of the biggest television markets in the country. That gamble paid off. Within weeks, John was working as a freelance reporter for 7News, and after several months of proving his value to the news team, he was hired full time to report for the morning show Today in New England.
